(a) to (d) The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports is implementing the Khelo India Scheme which inter-alia has a vertical of "Promotion of rural and indigenous/tribal games". In order to showcase our rural and indigenous/tribal games, annual competitions will be held annually under the Scheme in rural and indigenous/tribal games alternately. So far, traditional sports like bullock cart race and Jallikattu have not been supported under this Scheme, nor is there any proposal to promote

traditional games like bullock cart race and Jallikattu at present. Therefore, this Ministry is not maintaining any data regarding prevalence of such games in rural areas of the country.
