Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of people trained under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) since the inception of the scheme;
- (b) whether those trained under PMKVY have been placed in jobs or have acquired jobs after training and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the National Skill Development Corporation keeps records of jobs that have been created through PMKVY, quarterly or annually and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether any courses at training centres last less than 6 months and if so, the details thereof:
- (e) whether the scheme incentivises placements and if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether in continuous monitoring, 15 points for placements and 3 points for kaushal placement mela are the only placement related activities monitored and if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) the details of the amount paid as training incentive per candidate to training centres for placement of candidates?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI ANANTKUMAR HEGDE)

- (a) Under PMKVY, since inception, as on 01.02.2018, 44.13 lakh (appx.) candidates have been trained (29.91 lakh STT + 7.82 lakh RPL) / undergoing training (6.4 lakh appx.) under Short Term Training and Recognition of Prior Learning.
- (b) and (c) Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2015-16, it was not mandatory for Training providers to report employment data. However, as per the data reported on Skill Development Management System (SDMS), out of total 19.8

lakh trained candidates under PMKVY 2015-16, 2.6 lakh candidates have been provided with the placement offers.

Under PMKVY 2016-20, which started from 2nd October 2016 onwards, placement tracking is mandatory. The placement data is reported within 90 days of certification of trained candidate. As per data reported on SDMS, as on 01.02.2018, out of 11.8 lakh trained candidates under PMKVY 2016-20, 7.9 lakh candidates are certified. Out of the certified candidates, 2.8 lakh candidates have been placed in various sectors across the country.

- (d) Under PMKVY, all the courses offer are of short term and duration ranges from 190 hrs to 540 hrs.
- (e) and (g) Under PMKVY 2016-20, focus on employment has been significantly enhanced. The reimbursement of last 20% of training cost to TCs would be made only after wage employment or self employment to at least 70% of the trained candidates. Further, scheme incentivizes Training Centers (TCs)/ Training Providers (TPs) for facilitating placement of the trained candidates as per table below:

Placement Percentage	Amount Per Candidate
71-85%	3000/-
86% & More	5000/-

Also, TCs are mandated to organize placement/rozgar melas every six month with the support of Sector Skill Council. Additionally, there is a special provision in the scheme to provide post placement support to women, PwDs and candidates from special areas (LWE, North East region and J&K).

(f) PMKVY 2016-20 is endowed with various provisions relating to continuous as well as performance monitoring of training centre. The grading matrix under continuous monitoring constitutes 100 marks which include accreditation standards, compliance standards and performance standards. Out of this, 9 marks are for placement, 6 marks are for pass percentage and 3 marks are for organizing placement mela.
