**(a) & (b): Proposals from the States/UTs are received in the form of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) after detailed deliberations in conformity with existing schemes of the Union Ministry of Tourism, i.e. SWADESH DARSHAN and PRASHAD.**

**The number of proposals sanctioned and funds released to each of them under SWADESH DARSHAN Scheme and PRASHAD Scheme is at Annexure I and II.**

**(c) & (d): The Government had framed the National Tourism Policy in 2002. It envisages an institutional framework which is Government-led, private-sector driven and community welfare oriented. The broad framework of the policy is to:-**

- position tourism as a major engine of economic growth.**

- **harness the direct and multiplier effects of tourism for employment generation, economic development and providing impetus to rural tourism.**
- **focus on domestic tourism as a major driver of tourism growth.**
- **position India as a global brand to take advantage of the burgeoning global travel trade and the vast untapped potential of India as a destination;**
- **acknowledges the critical role of private sector with government working as a pro-active facilitator and catalyst;**
- **create and develop integrated tourism circuits based on India's unique civilization, heritage, and culture in partnership with states, private sector and other agencies;**
- **ensure that the tourist to India gets physically invigorated, mentally rejuvenated, culturally enriched, spiritually elevated and "feel India from within".**
