Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any assessment of the untrained teachers at primary education level across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the details of registered and unregistered teachers under the 'Swayam' and 'Swayam Prabha' schemes, State/UT-wise?

(a) & (b): The Right to Education Act, 2009 has been amended to extend the period of training of untrained in-service elementary teachers to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2019. All untrained in-service elementary teachers are required to acquire minimum qualifications as laid down by the academic authority by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2019. The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) has been entrusted with the task of conducting the training of untrained in-service elementary teachers. The details of untrained teachers with confirmed admissions at NIOS Portal is at Annexure-I.

(c): Three courses have been uploaded at 'Swayam' Portal so far by NIOS for the Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course being conducted for training of untrained in-service teachers. The details of Registration at 'Swayam' Portal as on 31.1.2018 is attached at Annexure-II.
