- (a) whether the Government and concerned Medical institutes have identified any emerging infectious diseases in India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether research is being conducted at the medical institutes in India with regard to such diseases and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether research is also being conducted in medical research institutions within India to find an effective vaccine or immunisation solution to prevent such diseases; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a) & (b): Yes. List of identified emerging infectious diseases, is annexed.
- (c): Yes, surveillance is kept to find out diagnosis and appropriate vaccine.
- (d) & (e): Yes. Research is a continuous process, however, for the present there is no specific outcome.
