VACANCY IN NATIONAL LIBRARY

3901. SHRIMATI K. MARAGATHAM:

Will the **Minister of CULTURE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to abolish 20% of the sanctioned posts at the National Library and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the posts remaining vacant for five years or more have to be abolished before recruitment is done for other vacant posts and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether 130 posts have been lying vacant in National Library for more than five years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Yes, Madam. 130 posts out of 561 posts of National Library, Kolkata have been identified for abolition as the same are vacant for more than five years. D/o Expenditure vide O.M. No.7(1)/E.Coord-I/2017 dated 12.04.2017 has issued instructions that existing posts vacant for more than 5 years are to be abolished immediately. Also, posts which are lying vacant for more than 2 years are to be deemed abolished. While referring any proposal for creation/revival of posts to D/o Expenditure, a certificate indicating that all posts vacant for more than 5 years on the date of referring the proposal, have been abolished is required to be enclosed. The group wise details of posts lying vacant in National Library for more than 5 years is as under:-

Group 'A' – 2 posts Group 'B' – 60 posts Group 'C' – 68 posts
