(c) the time by which the said work is likely to be completed;

(d) whether the NCERT has sought suggestions from teachers, experts and writers in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) whether the Government also proposes periodic review of books from private publishers prescribed by affiliated schools and if so, the details thereof?
