- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam, the government has launched on 22nd December, 2017 first homegrown high purity gold reference standard BND-4201.

The BND-4201 has been developed and manufactured by India Government Mint, Mumbai (A Unit of Security Printing and Minting Corporation of India Limited (SPMCIL) in collaboration with CSIR-National Physical Laboratory (NPL), New Delhi and Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) - National Centre for Compositional Characterisation of Materials (NCCCM), Hyderabad under an MOU singed in October, 2016.

The above reference material is Gold of 9999 fineness (gold that is 99.99 per cent pure)

(c) & (d): Yes Gold reference standard is required by the country's, Hallmarking Centres, Assayers, Refiners, Jewellers, Scientific Labs, Pharmaceutical Industry etc., to verify and ascertain the purity of Gold used for various purposes. Besides, artisans, pharmaceuticals and other high technology areas like space, communications, electronic Industries also require high purity certified reference standard.
