Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) has initiated the process of procuring all terrain, non-amphibious vehicle that will enchance navigation and deployment capabilities of the paramilitary troopers posted at the sensitive Indo-China border;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the total number of such vehicles proposed to be procured by ITBP; and

(d) the total cost of each vehicle along with the total budget earmarked for the procuring these vehicles?

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) is procuring 07 all-

terrain non-amphibious vehicle that will enhance navigation and deployment

capabilities of troops posted at the Indo-China border.

(d): The total estimated cost of 7 all-terrain non-amphibious vehicles (04 @

Rs.24,43,750/- and 03 @ Rs.32,58,334/-) is Rs.1,95,50,002/-.
