# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 4071 TO BE ANSWERED ON 20<sup>th</sup> March. 2018

### **Supply of Generic Medicine**

4071. SHRI MD. BADARUDDOZA KHAN:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is inadequate supply of generic medicines in the country particularly in Government hospitals and dispensaries;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that big pharmaceutical cartels are trying to thrust their highly priced medicines on it and to the patients;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to utilise facilities in the public sector pharmaceutical units to produce such medicines at cheaper costs; and
- (d) whether it would also arrange for production of vaccines to prevent speeding up of new generation communicable diseases in various parts of the country?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS; MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI MANSUKH L. MANDAVIYA)

- (a): The country is self-sufficient in medicines. However, a facility for reporting shortage of medicines, if any, by the public has been provided by the National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) through helpline number /Pharma Jan Samadhan / mobile number and twitter handle (<a href="https://twitter.com/nppa\_india">https://twitter.com/nppa\_india</a>). NPPA is monitoring about 97,000 Stock Keeping Units (SKUs) based on Pharmatrac data.
- (b): As per Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 2013 (DPCO, 2013), all manufacturers of Scheduled medicines have to sell their products within the ceiling price fixed by the Government. As regards non-scheduled formulations, the manufacturers are not allowed to increase the price by more than 10 % per annum.
- (c) & (d): The facilities of Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) in the country are already being utilised to produce quality medicines/vaccines at affordable prices which would also prevent speeding up of new generation communicable diseases in various parts of the country.
