Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Government and private schools in the country including Uttar Pradesh along with the number of students State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether there is a difference in the education system of Government and private schools and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to take any concrete steps to check arbitrariness of the private schools and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

- (a): As per Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE), 2015-16, State/UT-wise number of Government schools, Government aided schools and private unaided schools in the country, including Uttar Pradesh, along with the number of students enrolled therein is at Annexure.
- (b): No, Madam. Education at elementary level in Government, Government aided and private schools is regulated by the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009 and National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Guidelines; and secondary education is governed by the respective State Education School Boards and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), etc. All schools (both Government and Private) follow the National Curriculum Framework (NCF)-2005, which has been adopted or adapted by most of the states.
- (c): As Education is a subject in the concurrent list, a majority of schools are under the jurisdiction of the State Governments. It is for the State Governments to take action as per the existing law in case arbitrariness of the private schools is reported in their respective State.
