BOINDA RAILWAY STATION OVERBRIDGE

4238. SHRI NAGENDRA KUMAR PRADHAN:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a Fly Over Bridge on Talcher-Sambalpur railway line near Boinda railway station under the East Coast Railway which is under construction since twelve years but not completed so far;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the total cost of the bridge and the time by which the work of the bridge is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c): Construction of Road Over Bridge on Talcher-Sambalpur Railway line near Boinda Railway Station falls on National Highway. Therefore, the same is to be constructed by National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) at their own cost on single entity basis as per Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed on 10.11.2014 between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MORTH).
