## 43. SHRI KODIKUNNIL SURESH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been any significant reduction in mortality among children under age five due to diseases such as pneumonia, diarrhoea, neonatal infections and birth asphyxia between 2000-2015;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise during the last three years;

(c) whether the Government has identified States that are low performing in reduction of neonatal infections and diseases; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) & (b): According to the study 'India's Million Death Study' published in The Lancet, Oct 2017 Pneumonia and diarrhoea mortality fell by over 60%, mortality from birth asphyxia and birth-related trauma during delivery fell by 66% and measles and tetanus mortality fell by 90%. Under 5 Mortality Rate during the last three years is placed on **Annexure I.** 

(c) & (d): As per "India health of the Nation's states" 2017, released by Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), neonatal infection and diseases are an important cause of neonatal mortality. The details of neonatal mortality rate state-wise are at **Annexure II**.
