Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has earmarked any budget to complete the construction of Kundli-Manesar-Palwal highway;
- (b) if so, the reasons as to why the construction of the said highway is still incomplete;
- (c) whether the Government has fixed any time limit to complete the construction of the of highway; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) The construction of Kundli-Manesar-Palwal Highway (KMP Expressway) is being done by the Government of Haryana. However, the cost of land acquisition, utility shifting, project preparation etc. for both Eastern Peripheral Expressway (executed by National Highways Authority of India) and Western Peripheral Expressway (KMP Expressway) is to be borne by the Government of Delhi, Government of Uttar Pradesh and the Government of Haryana in the ratio of 50:25:25 respectively. The work of Manesar-Palwal stretch has already been completed and the work of Kundli-Manesar section of KMP Expressway has been awarded with scheduled completion date as Feb, 2019.
