**Funds to Andhra Pradesh**

- (a) the details of funds that the Union Government has released to the State of Andhra Pradesh after bifurcation of the State; and
- (b) the estimated costs and the funds released so far on projects promised under the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act?

(a): The Central Government has released funds to the State of Andhra Pradesh after its bifurcation under the following heads:

- In accordance to the commitments made by Union Government to the State of Andhra Pradesh GOAP under Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014 (APRA-2014).
- Funds released under tax devolution and grants-in-aid.
