- (c) whether the prices of some of the essential commodities were monitored by PMC for the last two years and if so, the details thereof, year-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has received all the necessary information on the price trends and availability of essential food items during the last three years and if so, the details thereof, yearwise:
- (e) whether it is true that the price of eggs has hit an all time high and eggs have become as costly as chicken; and
- (f) whether the Government is considering to take action to streamline the price of all essential commodities and if so, the details thereof?

(a) : Details of inflation rate as per All-India Consumer Food Price Inflation (CFPI), brought out by M/o Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) are as under:

- (b) to (d): The Price Monitoring Cell (PMC), set up in the Department of Consumer Affairs is monitoring, on a daily basis, prices of 22 essential food items which includes cereals (rice and wheat), pulses (gram, arhar, urad, moong and masoor dal), vegetables (potato, onion and tomato), edible oils (groundnut, mustard, vanaspati, soya, sunflower and palm oil) & others (atta, milk, sugar, tea, gur and salt). Price trends for last three years, based on the information from reporting centres is at **Annexure**.
- (e) : As per the Sub group level Consumer Price Index (CPI) brought out by MoSPI, the percentage increase in price of eggs in recent months of 2017 as are as under:

(f) : Government has taken various measures from time to time to stabilize prices of essential food items which, *inter-alia*, include appropriately utilizing trade and fiscal policy instruments like import and export duty, Minimum Export Price, export restrictions, etc. to regulate domestic availability and moderate prices; imposition of stock limits; and creation of buffer stock of up to 20 lakh MT of pulses and, provision of higher Minimum Support Prices to incentivize farmers for increasing production. Besides, Government is also implementing Price Stabilization Fund (PSF) scheme to help moderate the volatility in prices of agri-horticultural commodities like onion, potato and pulses.
