- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to re-write certain aspects of the ancient Indian history and text books and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the time by which the said panel is likely to submit its report to the Government along with the methodologies being used by the panel to study the evolution of Indian Culture and its history; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to place this report in the public domain and if so, the details thereof along with the time by which it is likely to be done and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (b) An expert committee has been set up for conducting holistic study of origin and evolution of ancient Indian culture since 12000 B.P. and to have interface with other cultures of the world. The concept note of holistic study included study of various stages of human evolution from the era of hunting gathering, domestication of plants and animals, Neolithic age, era of agricultural development, era of formation of social and cultural system, era of scientific development, era of urbanization, trade and cultural authorities etc. To carry study on above aspects experts/scholars from different fields viz. Archaeology, Anthropology, Linguistics, Geology etc. were considered for the committee. Following are members of the committee:
