**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of new courses introduced under the National Council for Vocational Training during the last three years and the number of new seats added to the existing courses along with the Statewise details thereof including Jharkhand and Bihar;
- (b) the other efforts made by the Government for Skill Development during the said period particularly in Jharkhand and Bihar along with the achievements made there under;
- (c) whether any new training institute has been set up under the National Council for Vocational Training during the said period; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Curricula of 22 new trades have been introduced under Craftsmen Training Scheme by National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) during the last three years. List of 22 new trades and state wise number of seat added to the existing courses are at **Annex-I** and **Annex-II** respectively.
- (b) Other efforts made by the Government for Skill Development during last three years are as under:
  1. Following schemes were formulated and implemented for expansion and up-gradation of infrastructure of ITIs :
    - i. Skill Development in 47 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism, which covers 47 Left Wing Extremism affected districts in 10 States including Jharkhand and Bihar. The scheme envisages establishment of 47 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in 47 district @ 1 ITI per district; 68 Skill Development Centers (SDCs) in 34 districts @ 2 SDCs per district and skill training of 5340 youth in 34 districts @ 160 youth per district.
    - ii. Up-gradation of existing Government ITIs into Model ITIs is a centrally sponsored scheme wherein 26 Government ITIs have been covered for up-gradation into Model ITIs in 25 States including Bihar and Jharkhand.

- iii. Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP) with World Bank assistance scheme, inter alia, covers upgradation of 400 Government ITIs. 34 State Governments/UTs are participating under the project including States of Bihar and Jharkhand.

Details of achievements made in above three schemes for State of Bihar and Jharkhand is given at **Annex-III**.

2. To strengthen the quality of vocational training, new affiliations norms for Civil Infrastructure and Standard Procedure for affiliation of ITIs have been introduced.
3. To raise the overall standard & quality of ITIs, they are being encouraged to acquire ISO 29990 Certification.
4. To ensure the quality checks of ITIs, grading system in ITIs, by awarding “Star Rating” to the performing institutes, has been introduced .
5. Dual System of Training’ (DST) in ITIs have been introduced from August, 2016 to fulfill the needs of industries, by combining practical training in the industry and theoretical training in ITI(s) .

(c) & (d) A total of **2742 ITIs** including **345 in Bihar** and **59 in Jharkhand**, were opened during last three years. State wise details of new ITIs opened during the last 3 years including State of Jharkhand and Bihar is at **Annex-IV**.
