- (a) whether the Government has taken or proposes to take any steps to monitor the progress made in implementation of the recommendations of Sarkaria Commission report on Centre-State relations;
- (b) if so, the details thereof as on date; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Sarkaria Commission in its report submitted in 1988, made 247 recommendations on Centre-State Relations. The Inter-State Council had deliberated on all 247 recommendations. Out of the 247 recommendations, 180 recommendations have been accepted and implemented. 65 recommendations have not been accepted by the Inter-State Council/Administrative Ministries. 02 recommendations are at different stages of implementation in the Administrative Ministries / Departments concerned.
