Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to establish more Indian Institute of Skills (IISc);
- (b) if so the details thereof;
- (c) whether this move empowers India's youth to be more employable and self-sustainable;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the list of States/places selected for establishing new IISc;
- (f) whether the IISc has any international collaboration and if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) the details of fund allocation and the expenditure incurred till date since its inception for the purpose?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Indian Institutes of Skills (IISs) are being established in the country to enhance training standards beyond the current programmes available in the skill eco-system and to provide 'hands on skills' training to trainees in specialised areas in collaboration with industry catering to local/ regional industry requirements.

(e) The States/ places selected for establishing IISs are Uttar Pradesh (at Kanpur), Maharashtra (at Mumbai), Odisha and Karnataka. Also, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has requested all State Governments to look into feasibility of providing land in setting up of IISs in different states.

(f) MSDE is in the process of identifying foreign partners for IISs.

(g) No expenditure has been incurred on IISs by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship till today.
