PRODUCTION AND PROCUREMENT OF WHEAT

5110. SHRI RAHUL KASWAN:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the estimated wheat production for the year 2017-18 and the details of wheat stock with the Food Corporation of India;
- (b) whether wheat stock with the Food Corporation of India has decreased and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to procure wheat from farmers through any active agency, if so, the details thereof and the scheme formulated for this and the time by which procurement process will be started; and
- (d) whether the Government has fixed any target for the procurement of wheat during the 2017-18, if so, the details thereof and the increase in the procurement of wheat in the current year as compared to that of the last year?

(a): The total production and stock of wheat in the country during 2017-18 is as under:

(b): No madam, The stock position of wheat during the last 2 years is as furnished below:

(c)&(d): The Central Government extends price support to paddy and wheat through the FCI and State Agencies across the country. The procurement policy is open ended. Under this policy, whatever foodgrains are offered by farmers, within the stipulated period & conforming to the specifications prescribed by Government of India, are purchased at Minimum Support Price (MSP) by the State Government agencies including Food Corporation of India (FCI) for Central Pool. However, if producer/farmer gets better price in comparison to MSP, they are free to sell their produce in open market i.e. to private trader/ anyone. The objective of foodgrains procurement by Government agencies is to ensure that farmers get remunerative prices for their produce and do not have to resort to distress sale. The statement showing Estimate and Procurement of wheat for Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2017-18; Procurement Estimates of wheat & Procurement Period during RMS 2018-19 is at annexure.
