STATUS OF AGRO PRODUCTS

5132. SHRI B.N. CHANDRAPPA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the current status of production of agro products that are imported by India;
- (b) the details of the agro products imported during the last five years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government is taking all necessary measures to increase the production of such agro products to pursue plans and strategies to meet the shortages of agro products and reduce the import dependency; and
- (d) if so, the outcome thereof?

ANSWER

- (a): Various agriculture products are imported by the country. Major agriculture products imported in value terms are vegetable edible oils, pulses, fresh fruits, raw cashew nuts, wheat, raw sugar, raw cotton including waste and spices. These products constitute nearly 90% share in India's total agriculture import. The current status of production of these major imported agriculture products is enclosed at annexure-I.
- (b): The details of major agro products imported during the last five year and the current year is enclosed at annexure-II.
- (c) & (d): In order to increase the production and productivity of agricultural crops including oilseeds, foodgrains, pulses, fruits and spices, Government implements various programmes/ schemes viz Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), National Food Security Mission (NFSM), Bringing Green Revolution to Eastern India (BGREI), National Mission on Oil Seeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP), Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana (PMKSY), Soil Health Card etc.

In addition, Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and State Agricultural Universities (SAU) have developed a number of improved varieties/hybrid seeds of foodgrain crops to enhance production and productivity of food crops.

As a result of various initiatives taken by the Government, record production of food grains(including both cereals and pulses)is estimated in the country during 2017-18.As per the Second Advance Estimates, production of food grains during 2017-18 is estimated at 277.49 million tonnes against 251.57 million tons in year 2015-16.Likewise, horticulture production (including fruits, spices, vegetables etc.) in 2017-18 is estimated at 305.43 million tons (as per the First Advance Estimates) against production of 286.19 million tons in 2015-16.
