#### MICRO AND MEDIUM IRRIGATION PROJECTS

5194. SHRI NIHAL CHAND:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether micro and medium irrigation projects have been included under the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) by the Government and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the allotment made by the Government to States/Union Territories under the PMKSY during the current financial year; and
- (c) whether drip irrigation and other related technologies are being promoted under the PMKSY, if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

- (a): Yes, irrigation projects are covered under Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY). Under these, ninety nine (99) ongoing Major/Medium Irrigation Projects having ultimate irrigation potential of 76.03 lakh ha., have been prioritized in consultation with States, for completion in phases by December 2019 along with their Command Area Development & Water Management (CADWM) works. Micro & minor irrigation activities including Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI) and Repair, Renovation and Rehabilitation (RRR) of existing Water bodies are also being undertaken under PMKSY- Har Khet Ko Pani. The PMKSY- Watershed Development also supports water conservation and harvesting activities through 8214 watershed development projects covering an area of about 39.07 million hectare in 28 States (except Goa), principally for development of rainfed portions of net cultivable area and culturable wastelands. PMKSY -Per Drop More Crop is being implemented for conservative and efficient use of water.
- (b): The State-wise release made by Central Government to States/Union Territories under PMKSY during the current Financial year is placed at Annexure.
- (c): Yes, DAC & FW is implementing Per Drop More Crop component with the objective to enhance water use efficiency in the agriculture sector by promoting Micro Irrigation technologies viz Drip and Sprinkler systems including micro-sprinklers, mini sprinklers, rain gun, etc.
