REMUNERATIVE PRICES FOR PADDY

5197. SHRIMATI JYOTI DHURVE: SHRI ASHOK MAHADEORAO NETE:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the production of paddy in the country during the last three years and the current year, State-wise and Year-wise till date;
- (b) whether the farmers engaged in the production of paddy in different States are not getting remunerative prices;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to ensure that appropriate remunerative price for paddy is provided to the farmers?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

- (a): State-wise details of production of rice during the last three years and current year i.e. from 2014-15 to 2017-18 (as per Second Advance Estimates) is given at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) & (c): Cost of production varies in different States on account of difference in levels of irrigation, resource endowment, farm mechanisation, land holding size, yield of crops etc. The Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices uses all India weighted average cost of production while making its recommendations on Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) and recommends uniform MSPs for the whole country which is applicable to all States/UTs. The MSPs fixed by the Government provides adequate returns over all-India weighted average cost of production. State-wise returns on MSPs fixed by Government over weighted average cost of production varies on account of variation in yield level and cost of cultivation of the crops. In case of paddy, the returns over weighted average cost of production ranges from 130.7 per cent in Punjab to (-) 1.2 per cent in Maharashtra for 2017-18. The lower return of paddy in Maharashtra is due to lower yield and higher cost of cultivation.

The return over weighted average cost of production (A2+FL) for MSP fixed by Government of paddy for 2017-18 in various States is at **Annexure-II**.

(d): Government has taken several steps to ensure remunerative prices to farmers for their produce which include fixing MSPs for major agricultural crops, undertaking procurement through designated procurement agencies, implementing e-National Agriculture Market, enacting the Model Agricultural Produce and Livestock Marketing (Promotion & Facilitation) Act, 2017 and promoting Farmer Producer Organization (FPOs).

The Government extends price support to paddy through the Food Corporation of India (FCI) and State agencies across country. Under procurement policy, whatever quantum that are offered by farmers within stipulated time period & conforming to the specifications prescribed by Government of India, are purchased at MSP by the State Government agencies including FCI for central pool. However, if producer/farmer gets better price in comparison to MSP, they are free to sell their produce in open market.

Further, the Union Budget for 2018-19 has announced the pre-determined principle to keep MSPs at levels of one and half time the cost of production.
