(a) whether the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) has trained a large number of people across the country for preparedness against manmade and natural disasters;

(c) whether the NDRF will take such type of initiatives to train more and more people in the country against natural disasters;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government for resilience and better preparedness against disasters?

(a) and (b): Yes, Madam. The details of various trainings conducted by the NDRF are as under:-

(d): NDRF is engaged in capacity building of the various stake holders and the community at large. So far NDRF has conducted 7,832 Familiarization Exercise, Community Awareness Programme and School Safety Programme (SSP) in the area of responsibility of each NDRF Battalion in which 56,96,408 people have participated.

Besides above, the mock exercise have been conducted for various stake holders like, Indian Railways, Metro, Major Accident Hazards (MAH) Units and Public Sector Units; as per details given below:
