The Government of India has issued National Transit Oriented Development (TOD) policy on 01.05.2017 after consultation with all States/ Union Territories (UTs) and urban transport experts. This policy is a guiding document for all States / Union Territories (UTs) to develop, notify and formulate State/ UT / city specific TOD policies for implementation of projects.
