MECHANISED SANITATION SYSTEM

5399. SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of railway platforms in the country where mechanised sanitation system has been introduced;
- (b) the details of expenditure incurred on introducing the above system at a station; and
- (c) the details of railway stations where mechanised sanitation system is likely to be introduced during 2018?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a) Mechanised Cleaning System has been introduced on 488 major stations (which includes platforms).
- (b) No separate data has been maintained. An amount of ₹ 539.66 cr has been spent till February 2018 by Indian Railways for Swachhta related activities at stations.
- (c) The Railways plan to introduce Mechanized Cleaning System on 97 more stations including platforms during 2018-19.
