(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. An Impact evaluation study has been conducted for 12th Five Year Plan (2012-13 to 2016-17) to assess the effective implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme- National Food Security Mission (NFSM) and to increase the foodgrains production in the country.

During XII Plan as against a target of 25 million tonnes of additional foodgrains production, the total foodgrains production is 275.68 million tonnes at the end of XII Plan. The production achieved in the foodgrain crops is as under:
