DEVELOPMENT OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

566. SHRI LAXMAN GILUWA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषिऔरकिसानकल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a big potential for development of animal husbandry and dairy industries in Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the details of study, if any, conducted by the Government in this regard; and
- (c) the efforts made by the Government in view of the said potential along with the progress made as a result thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRIMATI KRISHNA RAJ)

(a)to(c): As per 19th Livestock Census, there are about 87,30,000 Cattles and 11,86,000 Buffaloes, 5,83,000 Sheep, 65,81,000 Goat and 9,62,000 Pig in the State Jharkhand. During the FY 2016-17, the Milk Production was 1893.80 thousand tonnes in the State of Jharkhand. Hence, there is a huge potential for development of Livestock Sector in the State of Jharkhand.

The Government of India is implementing the flagship scheme, "White Revolution-Rashtriya Pashudhan Vikas Yojana" to supplement the efforts of State Government including State of Jharkhand for development animal husbandry and dairy sector including conservation and development of indigenous breeds in a holistic and scientific manner as well as genetic up gradation to enhance the milk production and productivity. A key objective of the scheme is sustainable development of livestock sector keeping view of livestock health, focusing on improving availability of quality feed & fodder, risk coverage, effective extension, improve flow of credit and strengthening of infrastructure for production of quality milk, procurement, processing and marketing of milk & milk products. The scheme "White Revolution- Rashtriya Pashudhan Vikas Yojana" has the following sub-schemes with focus on development of animal husbandry, cattle breeding and dairying:

- i. Rashtriya Gokul Mission
- ii. National Programme for Dairy Development
- iii. National Dairy Plan Phase-I
- iv. Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme
- v. National Livestock Mission
- vi. Livestock Health & Disease Control

The Government of India has released the assistance to tune of Rs.33.99 crore under different sub-scheme of White Revolution: Rashtriya PashudhanVikasYojana to the State of Jharkhand for the development of animal husbandry.
