- (a) Whether the Government has suggested limits on production of minerals such as limestone, as there is encroachment into agricultural land for mining of such minerals;

- (a) To (b) Yes Madam, the Ministry vide letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 has suggested the Ministry of Mines for carrying out a capping study for minerals like limestone. Further , the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) while appraising the project for grant of Environmental Clearance, inter-alia take into consideration the impact on land use and land cover of the area and if required restricts the mining activity to a limited area and to a limited production capacity.
- (C) and (d): No Madam, as on date the Government has not put any ceiling.
