(a) to (c): The Central Board of Secondary Education had initially used Aadhaar number for its All India Level entrance examination (except for the states of Jammu & Kashmir, Assam & Meghalaya).However, after the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2018, Aadhaar is no more mandatory and other proof of identity are also allowed like Ration card/ passport/ voter Identity card and Bank Accounts etc.
