Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Navodaya Vidyalayas are being run in each of the Lok Sabha constituencies in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the location thereof;
- (c) if not, whether the Government proposes to open a Navodaya Vidyalaya in Udaipur;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which it is likely to be opened; and
- (e) the names of the districts and constituencies falling under the Tribal Sub-plan areas in Rajasthan including South of the State where Navodaya Vidyalayas are being run?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): The Navodaya Vidyalaya scheme envisages opening of one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) in each district of the country. JNVs have been opened in all the districts of the country (as on 31.5.2014) which include Udaipur and other districts of Rajasthan.

The districts of Banswara, Dungarpur, Udaipur, Pratapgarh and Sirohi which are included in the Tribal Sub-Plan areas of Rajasthan have also been covered under the Scheme.
