(a) whether the National Investigation Agency is looking for some people who have gone off the radar after their names surfaced for receiving and sending funds on behalf of the Islamic States (IS) to establish its presence in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether it is true that these people have also helped people leave for Syria and Iraq; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a)to (d): NIA has investigated 23 cases related to ISIS in which 81

persons have been arrested and 39 are absconding. Some of the

arrested and absconding accused have either provided or received

funds for helping co-accused to go to the areas under the influence of

Islamic State (IS).
