## ENEMY PROPERTIES

## 5889. SHRI OM BIRLA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
(a) the details of enemy properties situated in the country, State-wise;
(b) whether the Government has any proposal to auction of the various enemy properties in the country and if so, the details thereof;
(c) the time by which such enemy properties are likely to be auctioned; and
(d) the mechanism and the authority which will be engaged by the Government in the process of auction of the enemy property?

## ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a): The state-wise list of 9406 enemy properties is as per Annexure-I.
(b), (c) \& (d): Section 8A of the Enemy Property (Amendment \& Validation) Act,2017 provides for disposal of enemy properties. The rules under the said amendment Act have been notified along with disposal order. The disposal order contains the mechanism and authority for disposing enemy property. No time frame has been fixed in the rules for disposal of enemy properties.
