Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to introduce a superfast train from Korba (Chhattisgarh) to New Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether there is also a proposal to introduce Sampark Kranti superfast train from Korba or Raigarh to New Delhi via Anuppur-Katni rail route;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the time by which the said trains are likely to be introduced by the Government?

ANSWER

(a) to (e). No, Madam. At present, there is no proposal to introduce train services including Sampark Kranti Express from New Delhi to Korba/Raigarh (via Anuppur-Katni). However, at present, New Delhi is connected to Raigarh by 3 pairs of train services which also provide connectivity to the passengers of Korba with changeover at Champa. Further, service of 12823/12824 H. Nizamuddin-Durg Sampark Kranti (Triweekly) Express is already available for the passengers of Chhattisgarh.
