610. SHRI BALABHADRA MAJHI:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has allocated sufficient funds under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme “Development of Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture” as per requirement of the State, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is considering to revise the unit cost as well as the corresponding subsidy thereon taking the scheduled rate and prevailing market rate; and
- (c) whether the Government is likely to give instructions to insurance companies to insure the fish ponds of fishermen, if so, the details thereof?
