TRAINING TO PORT PROFESSIONALS

Will the Minister of SHIPPING be please to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to impart training/skills to port and terminal professionals through modern technical workshops in various parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of funds allocated and utilized for the purpose along with the number of professionals trained during the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a) & (b): For imparting training/skills to port and terminal professionals, a center has been set up at Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust, Navi Mumbai in collaboration with APEC (Antwerp/Flanders Port Training Centre), Belgium. Fifteen training modules have so far been organized at this centre since February, 2015.
- (c): The expenditure on training of professionals is borne by the organizations concerned. 249 professionals have been trained at the above Centre in the last 3 years, out of which 17 have been trained during the current year.
