## 6415. SHRI RAVINDRA KUMAR PANDEY: SHRI NISHIKANT DUBEY:

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is determined to provide electricity to all villages in the country under the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of un-electrified villages in the country and the number of such unelectrified villages in Jharkhand; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to provide electricity to all the remaining villages?

### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR POWER AND NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY

(SHRI R. K. SINGH)

(a) to (d): Government of India, under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY), has targeted to electrify all the remaining un-electrified census villages across the country. As reported by States, there were 18,452 un-electrified census villages in the country, as on 01.04.2015. Only 323 census villages remained un-electrified as on 01.04.2018. It is targeted to electrify remaining un-electrified census villages by 1st May, 2018.

The State of Jharkhand has reported 2525 un-electrified census villages, as on 1st April, 2015; and these have now been electrified excluding 58 villages found uninhabited.
