(a) whether it is true that the Government is considering to set up National Blood Transfusion Service and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether it is also true that the Government has set up State blood transfusion councils in each State to monitor proper functioning of blood transfusion; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(c): State Blood Transfusion Councils are set up in all States and Union Territories with the exception of Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands. They are societies registered under the Society's Registration Act and created under the chairperson of Principal Secretary (Health) of respective States and UT.
