MARKET INTERVENTION SCHEME

671. KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE: SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE ‡ãðŠãäÓã एवं किसान कल्याण ½ãâ¨ããè be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has implemented Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) for procurement of agriculture and horticulture crops including Onion which are not covered under MSPs to protect the growers of these commodities from making distress sale in the event of bumper crop, if so, the details thereof ;

(b) the details of the production of Onion for 2015-16 and 2016-17 and the price at which onions were procured from farmers along with the steps taken by the Government for storage and preservation of onions, State-wise;

(c) whether the Government has floated tenders for import of onions to control onion prices, if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether it is a fact that India is the world's largest exporter of onions; and

(e) if so, whether the Government imposes limits like the Minimum Export Price (MEP), to discourage overseas traders from buying the commodity?

(a): Yes, Madam. The details of the Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) implemented since 2015-16 is placed at Annexure-I.

(b): Production of onion during the year 2015-16 and 2016-17 is 209.31 lakh MT and 224.27 lakh MT respectively. Onions were procured from farmers under Market Intervention Scheme at Market Intervention Price (MIP) which is indicated in Annexure-I. For storage of onion, there is a provision for construction of low cost onion storage structure under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH). For this, assistance is given @ 50% of total cost of Rs 1.75 lakh / unit for a structure capacity of maximum 25 MT. Since, 2014-15, 8,245 low cost onion storage structures for a total capacity of 2,06,125 MT has been established under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture.

(c): During 2015-16 a quantity of 2000 MT of onion was imported through MMTC to control onion prices. Further, during 2017-18, MMTC was directed to import 1000 MT of onion with provision for import of additional 1000 MT in the import tender. MMTC floated tenders twice, but no bids were received.

(d): According to trademap data, India is the 4th largest exporter of onions.

(e): Government had imposed Minimum Export Price of US\$ 850/ ton on export of onion to augment domestic availability and cool down the prices. Further, with the increase of the domestic availability, the Minimum Export Price has been brought down to US\$ 700/ ton on 19.01.2018 till 20.02.2018.
