Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to announce one time special package to certain States due to financial crunch they are facing;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the details of proposals for grant of special package under the consideration of the Government, State-wise including Kerala; and
- (d) the present status of these proposals?

- (a) & (b) There is no proposal with NITI Aayog regarding special package to states for financial crunch. As per the recommendations of 14th Finance Commission, the States' share in the net proceeds of the Union tax revenues has increased from 32% earlier to 42% for the period 2015-20. This would provide more untied resources to the States. The objective has been to fill the resource gap of each State to the extent possible through tax devolution.
- (c) & (d) Presently there is no proposal with NITI Aayog for grant of Special Package to any State including Kerala.
