CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS UNDER PMGSY

973. SHRI KANWAR SINGH TANWAR:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages where metalled roads are yet to be constructed under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), State-wise;
- (b) the number of villages where such roads have been constructed, State-wise;
- (c) the details of funds provided to States under PMGSY during the last three years, State and year-wise; and
- (d) the details of the provisions made by the Government to ensure post construction maintenance of roads constructed under PMGSY?

ANSWER

(a)&(b): 'Rural Roads' is a State subject and Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is a one-time special intervention to provide rural connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected habitations in the core network. PMGSY is executed through State Rural Roads Development Agency (SRRDA) at State level and Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) at district levels and timely completion of PMGSY roads is the responsibility of the respective State Government. Under PMGSY, the unit of programme is a habitation and not a revenue village. The number of eligible unconnected habitations as per the Core Network under PMGSY is 1,78,184, out of which the Ministry has sanctioned 1, 64,547 habitations till 31st December, 2017. The States have reported to have connected 1,30,974 habitations by all-weather road till 31st December, 2017. The Government of India has taken a decision to accelerate execution of all-weather road connectivity to eligible habitations for substantial completion of the habitation connectivity as per the Core Network of PMGSY by March, 2019. The State-wise details of habitations eligible and connected by all-weather road till December, 2017 is given at **Annexure-I**.

(c): The details of the fund released to the States under PMGSY during the last 3 years and the current year upto 1st February, 2018, State-wise and year-wise is given at **Annexure-II**.

(d): As per PMGSY guidelines, maintenance of roads constructed under the programme is the responsibility of the State Governments and all road works are covered by initial five year maintenance contracts to be entered into along with the construction contract, with the same contractor, as per the Standard Bidding Document. Maintenance funds to service the contract are required to be budgeted by the State Governments and placed at the disposal of the State Rural Roads Development Agency (SRRDA) in a separate maintenance account. On expiry of this 5 year post construction maintenance, PMGSY roads are required to be maintained by State Government through their own funds, from time to time. Further, the Ministry has advised the States to notify State Rural Road Maintenance Policy to ensure that the assets created under PMGSY are maintained on a regular and systematic basis. So far 23 States have notified the State Rural Road Maintenance Policy.
