Criteria for ODF Village

993. SHRI MALLIKARJUN KHARGE:

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the criteria or process throughwhich the Government declares a village asOpen Defecation Free (ODF);
- (b) the number of ODF villages inIndia, State-wise; and
- (c) the incentives provided by the Union Government to villages for ODF status?

ANSWER

- (a) A comprehensive community led decision making process is taken up for declaration of ODF villages. In the first step, villages themselves declare Open Defecation Free (ODF) in the General meeting (Aam Sabha). Within 3 months of ODF declaration, State/UT conduct ODF verification using different processes such as by using inter-district verification committees or third party verification committees. As Sanitation is a state subject, the States are encouraged to adopt a verification process best suited to the local conditions. In the third step, ODF declared and verified Villages are then enteredby the States on Online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) maintained by Ministry, which is in public domain. In the Fourth step, ODF sustainability verification, which primarily focuses on toilet usage is also conducted after a period of 270 days.
- (b) State/UT-wise, details of Open Defecation Free (ODF) declared villages are at Annexure-1.
- (c) Instructions have been written to concerned Central Ministries/Departments to prioritize their programmes in ODF villages. ODF declared villages are also prioritised in providing Piped Water Supply Schemes(PWSS).
