(a): Under UDAN-1, 27 proposals are awarded and it is expected to provide around 13 lakh seats per annum of which half will be covered by airfare cap of Rs. 2500 /- for approximately one hour of flying. Around 25 lakhs RCS (approx.) seats and around 55 lakhs (approx.) total passenger seats will be available per annum under UDAN 2.

(b): List of 43 Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) (12 underserved & 31

unserved) airports which are already upgraded is as below:

31 unserved airports are Adampur, Ambikapur, Bhatinda, Bikaner, Bilaspur, Burnpur, Cooch Behar, Jagdalpur, Jaisalmer, Jalgaon, Jamshedpur, Jeypore, Jharsuguda, Kolhapur, Mithapur, Kandla, Kanpur-Chakeri, Ludhiana, Mundra, Mysore, Nanded, Neyveli, Ozar (Nasik), Pathankot, Raigarh-JSPL, Rourkel, Salem, Shimla, Solapur, Utkela & Vidyanagar and 12 underserved airports are Agra, Andal (Durgapur), Bhavnagar, Diu, Gwalior, Jamnagar, Kadapa, Kullu (Bhuntar), Pantnagar, Puducherry, Porbandar & Shillong.
