- (a) and (b): Yes, Sir. HDFC Bank has signed an Agreement to enable Common Services Centres (CSCs) to become Banking Correspondents. As per the Agreement, Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) of CSC will work as Banking Correspondent of HDFC Bank and support the Government initiative to promote financial inclusion and make banking services more accessible in rural areas. Women, senior citizens and persons with disability will especially get benefitted through this initiative as it would enable financial transactions without the need for visiting bank branch.
- (c) and (d): There is no proposal with MeitY to this effect, however, HDFC Bank has offered to support the conversion of 1000 villages into digital villages.
