STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *273 FOR 06.08.2018 ASKED BY HON'BLE MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT DR. K. GOPAL AND SHRI ANOOP MISHRA REGARDING INDIAN UNIVERSITIES

(a) to (d) No. Madam, 24 Indian institutions have been listed in the top 1000 of the world best universities in the latest QS World Universities Rankings. The details of the 24 institutions are enclosed. Out of the 24 institutions, 3 institutions namely IIT Bombay, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and IIT Delhi are in the top 200 of the world best universities. IIT Madras, IIT Kanpur, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Roorkee, IIT Guwahati and University of Delhi also figure in the top 500 of the world best universities.

Indian higher education institutions have improved their research productivity and therefore are able to improve their rankings at the global level. In order to support these institutions, schemes such as IMPRINT and Uchhatar Aviskar Yojna have been launched which provide competitive based funding for research projects.

Further, most of these institutions have prepared a three-year action plan, seven-year strategic plan and fifteen-year vision plan for improving their global rankings.
