- (a) whether it is true that the railway network in Karnataka is very little in comparison to neighbouring States;**
- (b) if so, the details of the railway lines/network laid/introduced in the State of Karnataka; and**
- (c) whether the works of all the newly introduced railway projects/lines are being completed as per the schedule of the Railways and if not, the reasons therefor?**

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**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 101 BY SHRI D.K. SURESH AND SHRI NALIN KUMAR KATEEL TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 18.07.2018 REGARDING RAILWAY PROJECTS IN KARNATAKA.**

**(a): No, Madam. The Railway network of Karnataka State and its neighboring States is as under:**

**Karnataka – 3424 Route Km**

**Kerala – 1045 Route Km**

**Telangana – 1823 Route Km**

**Andhra Pradesh – 3817 Route Km**

**Tamil Nadu – 4028 Route Km**

**Maharashtra – 5784 Route Km**

**(b): Does not arise. However during last 4 years (i.e. 2014-18), approx 240 km of New line and 250 km of doubling has been commissioned.**

**(c): The completion of project requires coordination with various departments of State Government like acquisition of land, shifting of services etc. Moreover, the funds are allotted to each project on annual basis. Therefore, it is not feasible to fix time line for completion of the various projects.**

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
