AHMEDNAGAR-BEED RAIL LINE

†104. SHRI SADASHIV LOKHANDE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the construction of Ahmednagar-Beed railway line in Maharashtra has begun;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons for the delay;
- (d) the time by which it is proposed to be completed; and
- (e) whether a railway station has been set up for Jamkhed on the said railway line and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Ahmednagar-Beed section is part of Ahmednagar-Beed-Parli Vaijnath new line (261 km) project. Construction work of this line has begun and Ahmednagar-Narayandoh (12 km) section has been completed. Works have been taken up in remaining portion where land is available.

- (d): The completion of project requires clearances from various departments of State Government like acquisition of land, shifting of services etc. Moreover, the funds are allotted to each project on annual basis. Therefore, it is not feasible to fix time line for completion of the entire project.
- (e): The alignment of Ahmednagar-Beed-Parli Vaijnath new line does not traverse through Jamkhed.
