Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any unsettled boundary issues/disputes between India and Myanmar particularly along the border of the North Eastern States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the measures taken up by the Government to settle such issues/disputes with the Myanmar Government?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (c): There are no boundary issues/disputes between India and Myanmar. Boundary demarcation work remains to be completed in some sectors of India-Myanmar boundary. Regular dialogue is held between India and Myanmar on all issues related to boundary demarcation and border management through institutionalized mechanisms such as Foreign Office Consultations, National Level Meetings (NLM), Joint Boundary Working Group (JBWG), Sectoral Level Meetings (SLM) and Heads of Survey Department meetings.
