(a) & (b): As per the latest Annual Survey of Industries, 2015-16, the State/UT-wise total number of persons engaged by the registered food processing factories/unit by the year ending 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 is at **Annexure-I.** The State/UT-wise number of direct and indirect employment opportunities created under various Schemes of Ministry of Food Processing Industries during 2014-15 to 2016-17 is at **Annexure-II.** These schemes and the new schemes under the PRADHAN MANTRI KISHAN SAMPADA YOJONA envisage creation of direct and indirect employment for 5,30,500 persons by 2020.
